Nuclear Energy in Turkey

Turkey has had plans for establishing nuclear power generation since 1970. Today, plans for nuclear power are a key aspect of the country's aim for economic growth.

Application has been made for construction and operating licenses for the first plant, at Akkuyu, and construction start is expected in 2015. Akkuyu is expected to come online in 2020.

A Franco-Japanese consortium is to build the second nuclear plant, at Sinop.

China is in line to build the third plant, with US-derived technology. (not-certain yet)

A small uranium mining project is planned.
